

## ORDINANCE NO. 338-23

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF DEPOE BAY, AMENDING ORDINANCE 100 BY REPEALING  
SECTION 9 PROHIBITED PARKING AND ADOPTING  
ORS 819.110 PERTAINING TO CUSTODY, TOWING, AND SALE OR  
DISPOSAL OF ABANDONED VEHICLES WITHIN  
THE CITY OF DEPOE BAY**

**WHEREAS:** abandoned vehicles are occasionally located within the City of Depoe Bay; and,

**WHEREAS:** the City of Depoe Bay needs a process for vehicles abandoned within the City of Depoe Bay; and,

**WHEREAS:** the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office follows the process for abandoned vehicles specified in ORS 819.110, Custody, towing and sale or disposal of abandoned vehicle; and,

**WHEREAS:** the Lincoln County Sheriff Office's provides law enforcement coverage to the City of Depoe Bay; and,


**WHEREAS:** Ordinance No. 100 Section 9 is not needed if the City adopts ORS 819.110 as the process for vehicles abandoned within the City of Depoe Bay;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEPOE BAY:** The City of Depoe Bay adopts ORS 819.110 pertaining to the custody, towing, and sale or disposal of abandoned vehicles within the City of Depoe Bay; and,


**FURTHERMORE,** Ordinance No. 100 Section 9 Prohibited Parking is hereby repealed.

**FURTHERMORE,** this Ordinance is necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Depoe Bay and it is deemed necessary for this Ordinance to take effect immediately, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
