## ORDINANCE NO. 335-23 CITY OF DEPOE BAY

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 252, THE CITY OF DEPOE BAY HARBOR ORDINANCE; REVISING DEFNITION OF MOORAGE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Depoe Bay has adopted rules for the control and management of the harbor properties and facilities of the City of Depoe Bay (Ordinance No. 252); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Depoe Bay has determined that for the benefit of the harbor there is a revision to the definition of moorage; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of Depoe Bay hereby ordains as follows:

1. Ordinance No. 252, the City of Depoe Bay Harbor Ordinance, is amended as follows:

Section 92.05 Definitions. MOORAGE.

Any place where a vessel lies when at anchor or is moored in an assigned berth made fast (secured) to a dock or finger pier or is laid alongside another vessel made fast to a dock, and shall include side and multi-side ties.

MOORAGE FACILITIES. Those facilities of the city where vessels may moor to wharfs, docks, pilings, walkways, and finger piers.

WHEREAS, the adoption of this ordinance is necessary to preserve the peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Depoe Bay, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council of the City of Depoe Bay and approval by the Mayor.

**Introduced and passed** the first reading in a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Depoe Bay, Oregon, on this 7<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2023.

**Passed** at the second reading, placed on final passage, and adopted by the City Council of the City of Depoe Bay, Oregon, on this 21st day of March, 2023.

**Approved** by the Mayor of the City of Depoe Bay, Oregon, this 21<sup>st</sup> day of March, 2023.
