

## ORDINANCE NO. 333-22

### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 332-22 TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM MEMBERSHIP OF THE DEPOE BAY EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS COMMITTEE

**WHEREAS**, the City of Depoe Bay adopted Ordinance 332-22 establishing the Depoe Bay Emergency Preparedness Committee on September 6, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Depoe Bay has determined that for the benefit of the City, the membership of the Emergency Preparedness Committee be revised to increase the committee membership to up to five (5) total members: two (2) Councilors and three (3) resident and/or business members.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of Depoe Bay ordains as follows:

1. Sections 1.000 Emergency Preparedness Committee and 1.020 Term of Office are revised as follows:

1.010 Creation and Membership: The Depoe Bay Emergency Preparedness Committee is hereby created. The Advisory Committee shall consist of **up to** five (5) ~~three (3)~~ members to be appointed by the City Council. Of those members appointed, two shall be members of the City Council and all shall be residents of the City of Depoe Bay for not less than 1 year.

1.020 Term of Office: Except as hereinafter provided for the initial appointment of the Advisory Committee members, the term of appointment shall be for two (2) years. The terms of office for the initial Advisory Committee members shall be staggered:

(3) members, 2-year terms

~~(2) members, 2-year terms~~

(2) members, 1-year terms

~~— (1) member, 1-year term~~

2. Section 2.000 Organization of the Advisory Committee is revised as follows:


2.020 Quorum: Three (3) ~~Two~~ members of the Advisory Committee shall constitute a quorum.

Introduced and first reading passed at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Depoe Bay on this **1st** day of **November** 2022.


Passed the second reading and adopted by the City Council of the City of Depoe Bay on this \_\_\_\_\_ day of **November** 2022.
