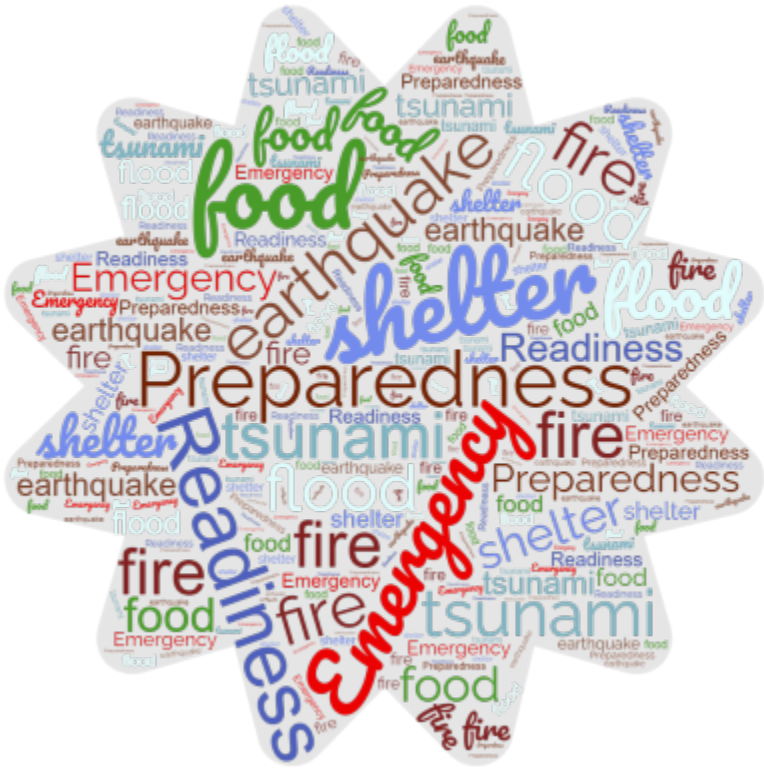


Emergency Preparedness
